Motion to Advance on Docket Due to Financial Hardship

Honorable Judge:

Pursuant to 38 C.F.R. § 20.900 (2012) (authorized by 38 U.S.C.S. § 7107), [veteran], through his undersigned counsel, respectfully motions this court to advance his claim on the docket due to severe financial hardship. [Veteran] lost his job through no fault of his own two months ago and has not yet received unemployment benefits from the State of Florida. He is a full-time college student and is currently paying his bills with his Veterans Reemployment Assistance Program (VRAP) benefits. The VRAP benefits will end in December and he will have zero income at that time.

A VA Form 5655 is enclosed showing [veteran's] current expenses and zero income from employment. There is also a past due rent notice and a Salvation Army Housing Plan from the last time he was homeless, late last year. Thank you for considering this motion.
